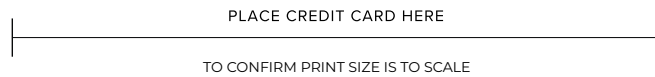




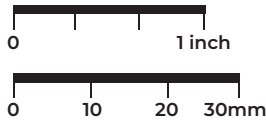
## ring size guide

### instructions

Use this guide to find your perfect fit. To ensure the sizing is correct, please print this page out on an A4 piece of paper, and make sure the scale is set to NONE or 100% in the print dialog box.

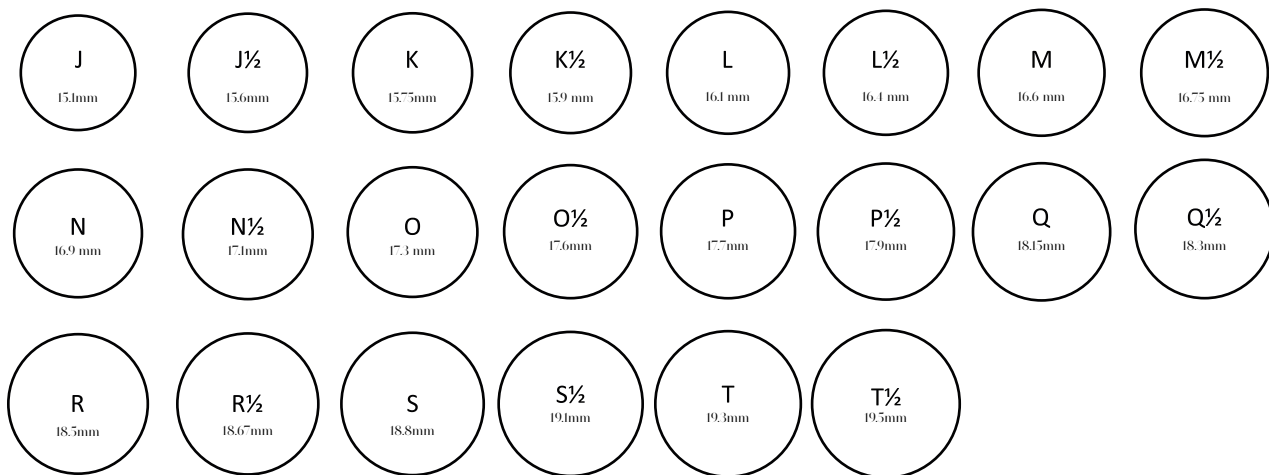


### OR CONFIRM PRINTED SCALE HERE



Measure the scale bar on the left to ensure it is exactly 1 inch or 30mm long. If the measurement is not accurate, check that you are printing the page at full size and reprint before continuing.

### match a ring you already own



1. Find a ring that currently fits
2. Place the ring over the nearest matching circle below
3. If the rings falls between two sizes, order the larger size
4. Double check for size accuracy

#### IF YOU'RE BUYING THE RING AS A SURPRISE

1. Ask the recipient's friend if they know their ring size.
2. Borrow a recipient's ring and measure as above

#### OTHER TIPS AND INFORMATION

- If knuckle is a lot larger than the base of your finger, measure both the base of your finger and your knuckle, and select a size between the two
- When considering a wide band, move up a size from your measurement for comfort
- Your ring size will be about half a size larger on the hand you write with.
- Measure your finger in warm temperatures, and at the end of the day
